DSA 2022 and NATSEC Asia 2022 were truly historic events for several reasons. Firstly, they marked a stellar comeback following a hiatus during the pandemic, concluding just a day before Malaysia reopened its borders. It was also the biggest event in Malaysia at that time, setting several benchmarks while witnessing signings of Memorandums of Understanding, Letters of Agreement and contracts worth more than RM7 billion by the Ministries of Defence and Home Affairs. DSA & NATSEC Asia 2022 also witnessed the coming together of 35,567 trade visitors, 380 VIPs, 1,096 participating organisations and 20 international pavilions.

More importantly, however, these events further cemented DSA's NATSEC Asia's status as being the only show of its kind anywhere in the world to feature both defence and national security-related issues side by side, on the same platform.
