Sagem Displays Patroller UAV For Civil, Military Missions

KUALA LUMPUR, April 21 (Bernama) -- Sagem, one of the world's leading suppliers of products and services for civil and defence applications, is promoting its Patroller UAV (unmanned aerial vehicle) to Asia-Pacific countries.

Its Chief Operating Officer in Optronic and Defence Division, Frederic Mazzanti said the Patroller UAV was very suitable to meet the requirements of both civil and military agencies.

He said it a safe and high-performance system developed to fulfill all types of homeland security missions, including the police, Customs and border control.

"The tactical drone system is used for discreet surveillance of sensitive zones during conflict, monitoring coasts zones and borders areas or areas affected by disasters from earthquakes to forest fires.

"It can even be used to monitor political meetings and sports events," he told Bernama on the sidelines of the Defence Services Asia 2016 exhibition and conferences at the PWTC here Thursday.

The Patroller UAV, one of the many Sagem products being highlighted at the DSA 2016, has a flight endurance of 20 hours based on a 250kg with its ceiling flying of 6,000 metres to a distance of 180 km and extendable to 500 km.

Its ground station give operators real time control, allowing them to accurately track mission progress, while providing high-precision target location.
